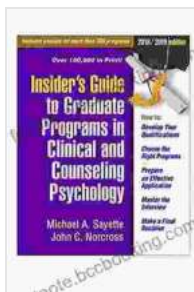

What is Clinical Psychology?

Clinical psychology is the branch of psychology that focuses on the assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of mental illness. Clinical psychologists work with individuals, families, and groups to help them cope with a wide range of mental health issues, including:

- Anxiety disorders
- Depression
- Eating disorders
- Personality disorders
- Substance abuse
- Trauma

Clinical psychologists use a variety of therapeutic techniques to help their clients, including:

- Cognitive-behavioral therapy
- Dialectical behavior therapy

- Family therapy
- Group therapy
- Psychodynamic therapy

Clinical psychologists typically work in private practice, hospitals, clinics, or schools. They may also work in research or teaching positions.

How to Become a Clinical Psychologist

To become a clinical psychologist, you will need to earn a doctorate in clinical psychology (Psy.D. or Ph.D.). The Psy.D. is a professional degree that prepares you for clinical practice, while the Ph.D. is a research degree that prepares you for a career in research or teaching. Both degrees typically take 5-7 years to complete.

In addition to earning a doctorate, you will also need to complete a one-year internship and two years of post-doctoral supervision. Once you have completed all of these requirements, you will be eligible to become licensed as a clinical psychologist.

The Job Outlook for Clinical Psychologists

The job outlook for clinical psychologists is expected to be good over the next few years. The demand for mental health services is growing as more and more people seek help for mental health issues. Clinical psychologists are also in high demand in research and teaching positions.

The median annual salary for clinical psychologists is \$79,820. The top 10% of earners make more than \$129,830 per year.

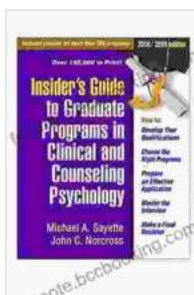
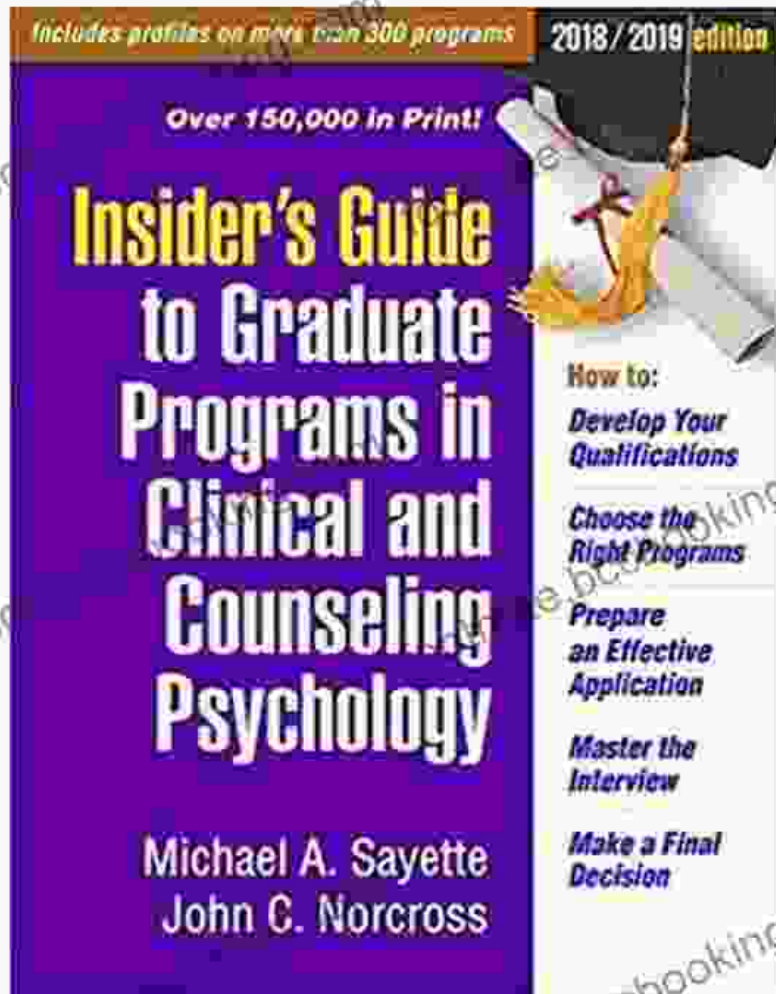
